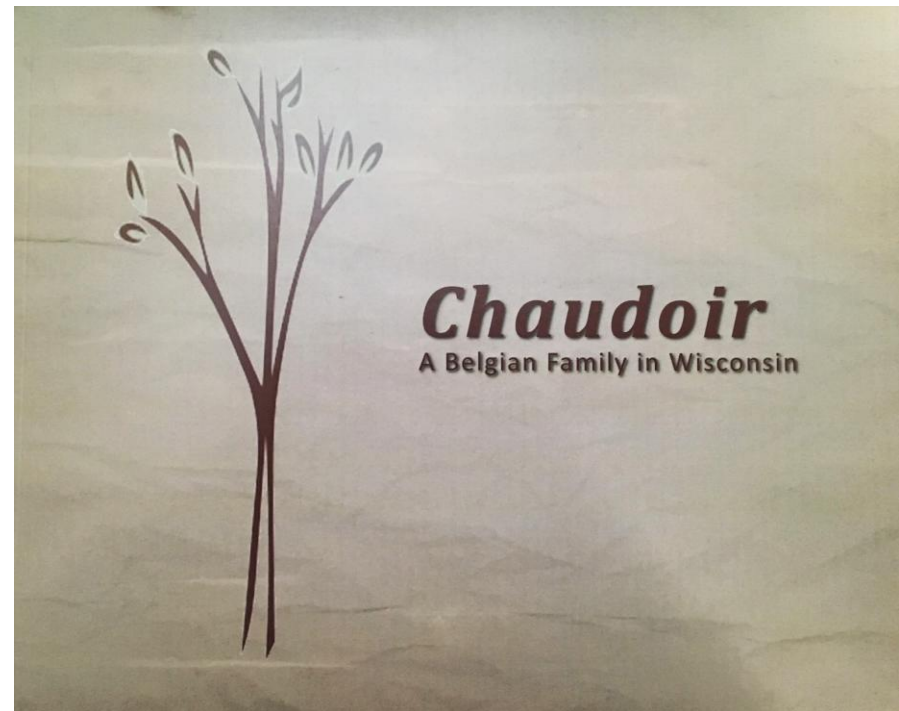
Francois

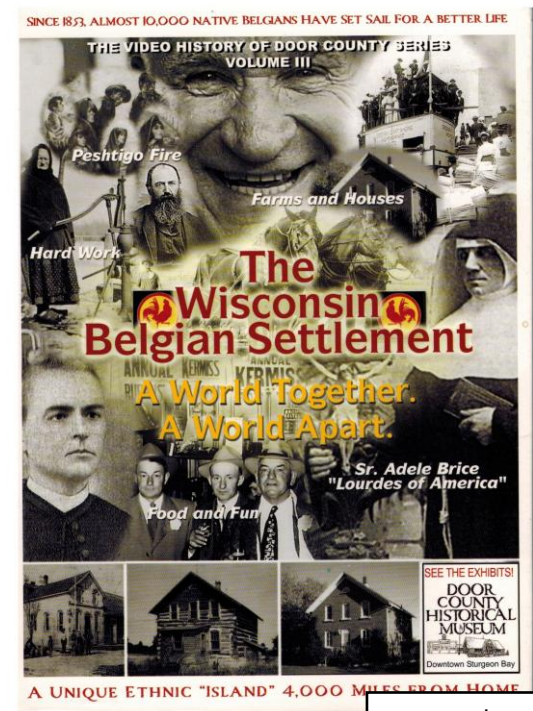
